
# **OBJECTIVES OF THE WEBINAR:**

- 7. discuss paramount methodological and ethical considerations in qualitative research;
- 8. apply basic analysis technique of qualitative data; and
- 9. apply the fundamental conventions in presenting results in a qualitative research.




# **PRE-REGISTRATION DETAILS**
