OBJECTIVES OF THE TRAINING-WORKSHOP:

- (1) To learn the journal publication standards of Scopus and Thomson Reu<mark>ters</mark> ISI (now Clarivate Analytics) as the framework of peer review;
- (2) To determine the roles and functions of peer reviewers in the quality assurance system of scientific journals;
- (3) To acquire skills in peer reviews; and
- (4) To compare various peer review forms as basis for benchmarking.
